

Instructions

During your international experience internship, write a diary can allow you to analyse some experienced situations, as well as your perspective, in order to improve your intercultural skills.

Please **write about 3 situations/problems/dilemmas and drop them off in the deposit box below, before the supervision seminars in order to discuss it.**

1. **At the beginning of the internship (after 2 weeks of initiating the internship)**
2. **Half way through your internship**
3. **At the end of the internship**

Instructions:

You **choose a specific situation of intervention** that you have observed (for example: an educator punishes a youth) or an intervention context (team meeting, meeting between participants, etc.) which shocks you, surprises you, or makes you feel uncomfortable.

You **describe this situation in a synthetic text** (if you prefer, you can also record it in a video). Once you have drafted the text (or made the video) you **post the result on the dedicated forum for this purpose.**

Share your chosen situations during the supervision seminars.

Goals:

The student will **be able** to put into perspectives his own actions **in order** to analyse his experiences, his knowledges, his behaviours and his attitudes. The student will also be able to compare his own frame of reference to those of the other participants and understand them with their frame of reference and worldview.
